God loves to see you having fun and enjoying the fun things He planned for you, so have fun playing this game.

Advance preparation:

Make a ball from scrunched paper and adhesive tape. Goals can be chair legs. Make 2 hockey sticks, each from a roll of newspaper taped together. Move all furniture away from the playing field and mark off the parameters of the field.

How to play:

(For smaller playing spaces)

 Divide the children into teams. Each team numbers off its players and chooses which end will be its scoring end. Player 1 in Team 1 and Player 1 in Team 2 begin in the centre of the playing area. Each try to tap the ball down to their end and through the goal posts (the chair legs). Whoever succeeds, scores a goal for their team. Next up are Players 2 from each team.

The goal of the game:

 The game ends when everyone has had a turn. The winning team is the team with the most goals.

(For larger playing spaces, you could have both teams playing at once, as in real hockey.)
